Remember the people of Madagascar today. The Malagasy Bible Society seeks to provide them with spiritual support via the Word of God as they continue to live with the impact of COVID-19.

5 January - Matthew 20: 1–16

In Malawi, Family Scripture Engagement Packs are being distributed by 'promoters' to families in rural areas. Praise God, there have been encouraging reports of people's lives being changed as a result of having regular access to God's Word.

- 6 January Matthew 20:17–28
 Pray for the Bible-based Trauma Healing work here in Scotland as training and healing groups move from online to face-to-face. Ask God to bless those taking
- 7 January Matthew 20:29–34
 The Dina Project in Mali aims to support young girls who are mothers and women who have been victims of violence. Many of these women experience feelings of hopelessness and despair. Pray that through encountering Jesus they might know healing and restoration.
- 8 January Matthew 21: 1–11
 Please remember the Bible Society of Mauritius as they seek prayer and financial assistance in order to increase their Bible work in that country.
- 9 January Psalm 28
 The Bible Society of Mexico is working to translate Matthew, Mark, Luke and John into the Chinantec of Ojitlán language. Pray that people's lives will be transformed through the power of God's Word.
- 10 January Matthew 21:12–22
 The Micronesia Partnership aims to make Bibles available and affordable to the population of the remote Micronesian Islands. Pray that the Spirit of God will touch hearts and change many lives in that place.
- 11 January Matthew 21: 23–27
 The Crieff Fellowship is taking place over three days, beginning today.
 Give thanks that the meeting can take place in person once again at Crieff Hydro, and pray for good fellowship and fruitful discussion for this group of evangelical church leaders.
- 12 January Matthew 21:28–32
 Give thanks with Christians in Morocco for the translation of the full Bible in Moroccan Arabic. This has been approved by the translation consultant and the steering committee of the project and is ready for print and digital publishing this year.
- 13 January Matthew 21:33-46
 Cyclone Eloise hit Mozambique in January 2021 resulting in loss of lives, damage to buildings and widespread flooding. Please pray for the Bible Society in Mozambique, as the cyclone also destroyed their depot in Beira and all the stock there was lost. Pray that God will lead them to find a new depot in a safer location.

14 January - Matthew 22:1–14

This year in **Myanmar**, as part of the local Bible Society's literacy programme, classes in reading and writing will be offered to 1,500 adult *Karen* speakers from rural areas. Pray that the Bibles given out to every student will result in changed lives.

Please pray that youth leaders will download the new resources which accompany *Dear Theo*. These are available on our website. Ask that the lives of many young people would be transformed as they engage with the books of Luke and Acts.

Please pray for the Bible message to be communicated in a way that is accessible and understandable to this special group of children.

- 2 February Numbers 13:1–3, 17–33

 A new series of animated films are being created to complement the *Joseph and the Triumph of Grace* book for teepagers. Please pray for everyone involved in
 - the Triumph of Grace book for teenagers. Please pray for everyone involved in making these films. Pray that the films will draw teenagers to the book of Genesis.
- 3 February Numbers 14:1–25
 The Seychelles Bible Society has been struggling since the beginning of the Coronavirus Pandemic. Seychelles' main source of income is from tourism and the pandemic has had a devastating impact on people's livelihoods.
 The dwindling economy and low Bible sales mean that the Bible Society will not be able to sustain its operations in the long term. Please pray for God to provide in this situation and to show them the way ahead.
- 4 February Numbers 14:26–45
 Give thanks for the people in Sierra Leone who have started to interact with the Scriptures through the Jesus Film and the Faith Comes by Hearing listening groups. Pray that listening group members who are literate will also benefit from their free printed copy of the Bible.
- 5 February Numbers 15:22-41

 Due to improved fundraising and the development of a new e-shop, the Slovak
 Bible Society has gathered the resources to start several new projects. Pray that
 their ministry will have a growing impact in Slovakia.
- 6 February Psalm 32
 Priests and Catholic pastoral lay workers are partnering with the Bible Society of Slovenia to form small Bible reading groups. Pray that the groups will encourage Catholic Christians in Slovenia to engage with the Word of God, apply it to their lives and share it with friends.
- 7 February Numbers 16:1–50
 Please pray for Norman Liddle as he shares about on the work of the Scottish
 Bible Society with the Guild at Cellardyke Parish Church in Fife today. Pray that people will be inspired as they hear about what God is doing around the world.
- 8 February Numbers 17:1–13
 Give thanks that an IT upgrade has been implemented within the Bible Society of the South Pacific. Staff there are now able to work remotely and also continue with networking and planned activities through online meetings.
- 9 February Numbers 18:1–32
 Please pray for church small groups meeting across Scotland and using SBS
 Equip resources to study the Bible together.
- 10 February Numbers 19:1-22
 The Bible Society of Spain works to provide Hebrew and Greek Bible Texts to students of theology. Pray that future leaders and translators will be helped to grow and develop spiritually through having access to these resources.

11 February - Revelation 1:1-8

Bibles in Braille and Audio are being published for people living with visual disability in **Sri Lanka**. Pray that the work of the team at the Ceylon Bible Society will make a lasting difference to the lives of this group.

Out of the seventeen ethnic groups in the Southern Blue Nile region of **Sudan**, the *Uduk* people are the only group where the majority are Christian. Please pray that the First Bible in the *Uduk* language will soon be published for them.

13 February - Psalm 33

Remember the Suriname Bible Society as they translate a book of Bible Stories for Children in the *Aukan* and *Saramaccan* languages. Dutch is the main language spoken in **Suriname**, and is used in school. However, having the Bible in their heart language would given children a better understanding of God's Word.

- 14 February Revelation 2:1-7
 Pray for the work of the Bible Society in Syria. Wade Al-Nasara, which translated means Valley of Christians, is so-called because of the number of Christian believers living there. Due to the economic hardship in the area believers cannot afford to buy a Bible and the demand increases each year. Pray that the Bible Society in Syria will be able to fully meet the need for God's Word there.
- 15 February Revelation 2:8-11
 Elaine Duncan is speaking at the Strathclyde University Christian Union in
 Glasgow today. Pray for all Christian students that their faith will continue to
 grow and flourish, and for good fellowship and support for each other.
- 16 February Revelation 2:12–17
 Pearl Liddle will be facilitating Initial Training for Bible-based Trauma Healing in London, beginning today. Pray for openness as God's Word is shared and for opportunities for attendees to run groups back in their own communities.
- 17 February Revelation 2:18–29
 The Bible Society of Tanzania is reaching out to orphans and vulnerable children in the Mbarali district of Mbeya. Pray that teaching in life skills and interaction with the Word of God will bring hope and transformation.
- 18 February Revelation 3:1-6
 Publishing a *Thai Study Bible* is a priority for the **Thailand** Bible Society. As each Bible book is finished it is published individually rather than waiting until the whole Bible is complete. Praise God, this way believers will be able to study the Scriptures as soon as possible.

- The Bible Society of Togo is distributing Children's Bibles to Sunday schools in the north of **Togo**. Pray that as a result many children will get to know Bible stories and develop a regular Bible reading habit.

- 20 February Psalm 34
 Elaine Duncan is speaking at Seagate Church in **Troon** this morning. Pray that the congregation will be encouraged as well as challenged by Elaine's message.
- 21 February Revelation 3:14–22
 The Bible Society of Uganda aims to help people with visual impairments to own a Braille or Audio Bible. Pray that people living with a visual disability will grow to love God's Word and share about Jesus with their friends.
- 22 February Revelation 4:1-11

 Word of Hope to Crisis Families reaches out to broken families with God's Word in Ukraine. Please pray with the Ukrainian Bible Society that whole families will find encouragement, peace and guidance on how to live in harmony.
- 23 February Revelation 5:1-14
 Grow and Learn booklets, containing Bible excerpts, are being distributed amongst Sunday school classes in Uruguay. Pray with the Bible Society of Uruguay that every booklet received will result in spiritual growth in each young life.
- 24 February Revelation 6:1–17
 The Audio Bible in the Uzbek Language has now been recorded. Please pray for negotiations to make a presentation about this project at state level. Pray that the presentation will go ahead and be well-received. Pray that permission will be given to allow the audio Bible to be freely distributed in Uzbekistan.
- 25 February Revelation 7:1–17
 The United Bible Societies in Venezuela is working to translate the Bible into the Sign Language. Please pray that God will use his living Word to change peoples' lives in the Venezuelan deaf community.
- 26 February Revelation 8:1–13
 Please pray Neil, Fiona and Jen, our *Outspoken Bible* podcast team.
 The podcast provides an engaging and thoughtful discussion for people to listen to, discussing the Bible in a contemporary format.
- 27 February Psalm 35
 Pray for the West Balkan Partnership. One of the purposes of this group of
 Bible Societies is to establish relationships with leaders and key people in
 churches in the area with the aim of encouraging them to prioritize Bible use in
 their congregations.
- 28 February Revelation 9:1-21
 Pray that through the 100 Steps Family Bible Challenge many parents in the West Indies will begin to read the Bible regularly with their children. Ask for God to speak through his Word and help whole families to grow in faith.

 The Bible Society of El Salvador reaches out to gang members who find themselves serving time in prison, supporting them and helping them to discover the God of the Bible. Pray that through hearing the Gospel message many prisoners will respond to Jesus and turn away from gang culture.
- 2 March Revelation 11:1-19
 Give thanks for the opportunity for Norman Liddle to update the Guild at Erskine Parish Church today on our work. Pray for a good response to what is shared.
- 3 March Job 22:1–30
 Remember the translation team working on the First Chikunda Bible, for the Chikunda community in Northern Zimbabwe. Pray that the Bible will help to win new Christians and reaffirm the faith of existing believers in that country.
- 4 March Job 23:1–17
 In Zimbabwe Faith Comes by Hearing groups use audio recordings of the Bible to share the Scriptures with those who struggle to read. Pray that listeners all over the country will respond positively to the Word of God.

5 March - Job 24:1-25

5 First developed by the British and Foreign Bible Society Open the Book shares SAT the Bible with children through interactive story-telling. Pray for Open the Book, now in its third year in Albania. Praise God, the Interconfessional Bible Society of Albania is using it in a variety of outreach programmes in that country.

Pray for the Bible Society in Angola as it reaches out to the half a million prison inmates in that country. Please pray that gifts of Bibles, New Testaments and Bible reading notes will be used by God to transform the lives of many prisoners.

7 March - Job 25:1- 26:14

Real News, run by the Argentine Bible Society, aims to give young people across Argentina access to the New Testament. Please pray that through the reading of God's Word many will get to know Jesus personally.

8 March - Job 27:1-23

The Interconfessional Bible Society of Moldova is distributing Family Bibles to vulnerable families, single parents, and the elderly. Pray that families who read the Bible together will become more unified as they interact with the Word of God.

9 March - Job 28: 1-28 9

This year the Paraguayan Bible Society celebrate 10 years of Bible work in the riverside communities of Paraguay. Please pray that God will give staff grace to continue serving in those remote areas.

10 March - Job 29:1-25 **10**

The Scottish Bible Society Board meets today for the first of its quarterly meetings this year. Give thanks for the time and commitment the Trustees give to the Society, and for the expertise each person brings to the Board.

11 March - Job 30:1-31

Work on the Pinuyumayan First New Testament continues in Taiwan. Members of the translation team are sometimes asked to help with language teaching, which has made translation progress slower than planned. Please pray for the team as they balance various work commitments and complete the whole New Testament as soon as possible.

12 March - Job 31:1-40

12 A series of booklets entitled History and Archaeology have been prepared by the SAT Bible Society in Turkey. The books provide information about Biblical events which have taken place in **Turkey**. Pray that the booklets will generate further interest in the message of the Bible.

13 March - Psalm 37

13 Pray for prison inmates who receive a copy of God's Word from the SUN Bible Society in Puerto Rico. Pray that they will begin to understand God's love for them, and encounter Jesus through reading the Bible.

- 14 March Job 32:1–22
 Praise God, as part of the Bible Society of South Africa's bicentennial celebrations, the Society are making 2 million Bibles and 2 million sets of literacy materials available to the Christian community in **South Africa** in all the 11 official languages.
- 15 March Job 33:1–33
 The Bible Society of Zambia uses a delivery van to distribute Bibles all over the country. Pray that a new vehicle can be bought soon. Pray also, for the many Zambians who rely on deliveries from the Bible Society, for example secondary school pupils waiting on Good News Bibles for their Religious Studies classes.
- 16 March Job 34:1–37
 Give thanks for the work being done amongst migrant workers and refugees in Malaysia by the Bible Society and partner organisations in that country.

 Praise God that during the pandemic, education, practical needs and emotional support were offered as well as Bibles.
- 17 | 17 March Job 35:1–16 | Transforming Scotland gathers in Edinburgh this month. Give thanks for participating church leaders as they discuss issues facing the Church in Scotland.
- 18 March Job 36:1–33

 Many people in this country have recently been struggling with isolation, loneliness, fear and loss. Pray that volunteers throughout Scotland who are facilitating the Bible-based Trauma Healing groups will know God's wisdom as they come alongside people who are hurting.
- 19 March Job 37:1–24
 Pray for the Ovahimba and the Ovadhimba people of Namibia. They live in semi-nomadic communities where the spoken rather than the written word is used. Some are Christian but few experience lasting change in their lives due to the lack of interaction with God's Word. Give thanks that an Oral Bible Translation for the Ovahimba is now in production.
- 20 March Psalm 38
 Scripture Union Scotland will be gifting a copy of *Joseph and the Triumph of Grace* to every young person who attends their holidays in 2022. Pray that these young people will experience God's grace in their own lives.
- 21 March Job 38:1–21
 The Bible Society Nigeria is currently translating the Bible into the *Epie* language. Give thanks that a programme is also being set up to offer reading and writing tuition to illiterate *Epie* speakers.
- 22 March Job 38:22-41
 Pray for the 60 Roma children who completed the literacy program run by the Bible Society of Serbia last year. Give thanks for the teachers who lead the classes.
 Give thanks that each teacher is a mentor who will continue to care about the child's education and well-being as well as their personal relationship with God.

7 23 March - Job 39:1-30

Please pray for the SBS Communications team as they prepare Bible resources around our 2022 theme of *Light and Life* from John's Gospel.

24 March - Job 40:1-24

Christians living in **Tajikistan** are in a very small minority. Please pray that the Bible will become more widely available in that country. Pray also that God's Word will speak to persecuted Christians there and pray that their faith would be strengthened and their hearts encouraged by it.

25 | 25 March - Job 41:1-34

Please give thanks for our partnership with Biblica/NIV who support us with many Bible distribution projects, including our Gospels and children's books.

26 March - Job 42:1-17

There are 528,000 people who speak the *Ossetic* language in **Russia**.

Please pray for Russian Orthodox believers in that country as the Russian Orthodox Church begins to use the new *Bible* in the *Ossestic Language* in their liturgical services. Pray that as the Bible is used in schools and at home in personal devotions faith will grow.

27 | 27 March - Psalm 39

10 Must Know Bible Stories is an educational resource available from SBS providing Bible-based RME resources in **Scotland**. Please pray for teachers as they use and adapt these lessons in schools.

28 March - Matthew 24:1-14

Audio Bible-based Trauma Healing courses are being used to minister to traumatized people living in **South Sudan**. Please pray for the people of this country as they have had to endure the longest-running and most brutal civil war in Africa. Pray that the Holy Spirit will bring peace to broken minds and hearts and lives will be restored to the glory of God.

29 | 29 March - Matthew 24:15-35

Please pray for the SBS staff responsible for continuing to adapt our *Bibleworld Books* resources for use online. Please pray that the illustrations and Bible stories will inspire a new generation of children.

30 March - Matthew 24:36-51


Progress is being made towards publishing a new *Vietnamese Study Bible*.
